## Significant Events and/or Alarms

- Both engines passed annual pump testing performed by Kent County Purchasing vendor WW Williams at Cedar Springs FD. Both engines passed the test, however an issue with the fan clutch on E-2 was detected. A quote is being prepared. FF Spencer assisted with jockeying trucks back and forth.
- Annual SCBA flow testing occurred on June 27.
- On June 4, SFD was assigned an Automatic Aid response to Kent City FD on a residential structure fire. SFD responded with two apparatus and five personnel. Personnel performed vertical ventilation (cut a hole in roof for smoke to escape) and also assisted with fire attack (crew operated hose line on red stuff inside the structure).
- Insurance inspector for the new fleet insurance provider, MML, through the Kent County Fire Commission completed a general visual inspection of the SFD Fleet and did not find any concerns
