- Electrical inspector approved sidewalk lighting project, to be landscaped
- Target Solutions provided an informational webinar for Administrative users. Following this event, an invite was sent to all personnel to complete a similar introductory training. One of the first assignments for the command staff was to complete the training for "Reasonable Suspicion" regarding violations of the drug and alcohol free workplace policy.
- Deputy Chief Paige and Captain Gabrielse participated in a user overview webinar for the new state compliant EMS reporting software. This was followed with an introduction meeting for the rest of the staff.
- On June 15, the annual NFPA 1582 exam testing occurred for six members at SFD. Other members are scheduled at other locations in August.
- On June 21, SFD responded to a structure fire in a residence at 13386 Lime Lake Road. Automatic Aid was provided by Algoma, Sand Lake, and Kent City Fire Departments. An offensive attack by Solon E-1 proved to be extremely successful. This attack limited the fire damage to mainly one floor of the home. The investigation for cause and origin is still undetermined. The Kent County Sherriff office is conducting the investigation. The occupants were all able to escape the residence prior to FD arrival. There was not any fire or civilian injuries. Damage loss estimate is \$150,000.
- Deputy Chief Paige excused his presence from SFD from June 9 to 19 to serve on a mission trip in Utah with his church. A big thank you for all the staff members that provided the extra effort to both cover the station and to respond to every alarm. Not a single alarm went unanswered. Kudos to FF Schievink and Capt. Gabrielse for the station coverage particularly.

- FF Hunt was on medical leave during this same time frame. As the notoriously highest average respondent, this made for a skeleton roster of resources. Again, thank you to the whole staff for responding.
