- On 9-6-16, a new vendor was utilized via the Kent County Purchasing to perform annual NFPA hose testing. The awarded vendor was \$ 0.06 per foot cheaper than the next lowest bidder. The vendor was established in Germany and recently ventured in to the US Fire Service. There was a two day delay from the scheduled date due to mechanical difficulties while traveling. Overall the vendor provided a certified test document for all hoses and ladders at a significant savings, and I will recommend using again.
