Solon Township Board

My name is Tom Decker. I live on Snauble Ave. I am here this evening to publicly thank and praise the first responders of Solon Township. My wife, Catherine, was diagnosed with Alzheimer's in 2009. Recently her neurologist told me she was in stage three, which means moving toward the end of life.

On February first she collapsed in our home. She was not breathing. I called 911 and per their instructions began chest compressions. Within five or six minutes EMT's were there and immediately went to work to revive my wife. They worked feverishly and diligently until the ambulance arrived and then continued to work with them. At the same time, they were communicating with me, letting me know what her condition was and what they were doing. I must admit I was in complete panic mode. Plus, they were dealing with a small dog who I was unable to catch and who was persistent in being right in the middle of everything.

Through the efforts of these men my wife's heart started beating again and she was transported to Mercy Hospital. Sadly, she did not regain consciousness and passed away on the evening of the second. That was God's will, not our first responders. At my request, they did everything possible in their efforts to save her. They were obviously well trained, dedicated, driven, and efficient, yet compassionate and understanding.

My one regret is that due to my state of mind that morning I was not able to shake the hands of each person who came to my house and worked so hard to try and save her life. In fact, except for Jeff, who I believe told me he was the fire chief, if I saw them today I probably would not recognize them. I do want them to know how grateful I will always be for their service to my wife. Even though I don't know them, they are my heroes. If it is permissible, I would ask that this letter be made a part of the minutes of this meeting so that all the residents of this township can know what amazing people stand ready to serve them in time of crisis. 
