Significant Events and/or Alarms

- FF Dan Spangenberg has resigned after faithfully serving SFD for over 11 years. FF Spangenberg sold his home recently and has moved to Oakfield Township.
- FF Brian Spencer also has retired after relocating to Galesburg MI having served two years with SFD.

- The new ACCD awarded to SFD via the Firehouse Subs Community Foundation arrived in mid-November. A Standard Operating Procedure has been drafted and distributed to personnel. A training night has been planned for December 4. The equipment should be in service to provide optimum chest compressions for our customers immediately following this event. Please remember Firehouse Subs generous donation when you are choosing a restaurant while shopping Alpine Avenue in Comstock Park.
- Deputy Chief Paige traveled to the DNR Rose Lake Facility and picked up the Breathing Air Compressor awarded to SFD via the Michigan DNR and the Federal Excess Equipment program. Install and operational costs to be determined. The Chief Officers have agreed on the placement selection of building # 1 next to the sump pump. FF Grady covered the station during this trip.
- On November 14, SFD was requested to assist Algoma FD at a motor vehicle crash at Algoma Avenue and Indian Lakes. SFD was assigned to land Butterworth Aero Med Helicopter and assist Kent Sheriff with traffic control by closing Algoma Avenue at 16 Mile Road.
- On November 25, SFD responded to Clear Lake near the State of MI access road for a report of a truck submerged in the lake. The 911 caller stated that the truck was first noticed at 0630 hours and the alarm time was 1230 hours. Not sure why they decided to wait six hours? Nonetheless, SFD requested the Hover Craft from Cannon Township FD to respond to assist with a possible water rescue. Chief Drake arrived on scene and found a 4x4 Dodge truck about 6 feet in the water from shore with water up to the front floor pan. The vehicle was found to be empty and Cannon FD was quickly disregarded. The investigation was transferred over to the Kent Sheriff.

- Two different dates in November presented events that involved simultaneous alarms for SFD. Both events were mitigated as SFD responded along with the aid of Sand Lake and Cedar Springs FD.
