- An alarm for the possible release of a hazardous powder on 10-16-19 at 2141 Winston View was investigated and determined to be a "good intent" call. This alarm was simultaneous with a rescue call for an injury crash at 17 Mile and Pine Island. Mutual aid for both alarms was requested from Kent City, Algoma, and Cedar Springs FD.
