Outside of Station Functions, Significant Events, Alarms:

- On 8-18-2020 FF Matt Schievink was recommended by Chief Drake to promote to fill the full time position at SFD. The Board concurred with an action item at the Board Meeting. FF Schievink will start 9-8-2020 working 50 hours a week during the day.
- FF Schmidt and Lt. Robinson finished the repair work on the dry hydrant at Lime Lake. A special thank you to FF Schmidt for the use of his mini-excavating equipment for this work.
- FF Schievink, Grady, and Bobo provided partial coverage of the vacant full time position during the month.
- Solon FD has aligned with Bad Day Industries to host a MFR class starting in mid-October running through mid-January. MFFTC Fireworks Funding is being sought to reimburse the tuition cost of \$ 1,000 per student. SFD is planning on having three members attend.
- On 8-28-2020 another severe localized storm passed through Solon Township in the late evening. This storm brought down numerous and incredibly large, mature trees from the area

of 19 Mile and Trenton moving south east over Algoma, 18 Mile, Solon, and Wiersma Roads and all the way through the heart of downtown Cedar Springs. The tree fall condition on 19 Mile and Algoma Roads made access to the fire station incredibly difficult as members tried to respond. Not to mention the large oak tree that fell directly in front of the station blocking any eastbound departure from the station. With the limited access to the station, Chief Drake made contact with the Kent County Emergency Management (KCEM) Director and requested aid for clearing the roads. The KCEM Director contacted the Kent County Road Commission Director who dispatched multiple crews and excavators to clear the primary roads. SFD responded to over 20 alarms for wires down, a vehicle crash into a tree, and G2 Erectors suffered a vehicle fire that was erroneously dispatched to the Algoma FD who mitigated the alarm. Kent City FD responded with three apparatus and six personnel to assist SFD with the heavy simultaneous alarm count. The FD was without power from this storm through mid-day 8-30-20. A special thank you to FF Schmidt for re-fueling the generator by use of his portable diesel tank on his personal truck.

- On 8-16-20 SFD responded to a fatal motor vehicle accident in the 1700 block of Seventeen Mile Road. This event was a level 1 Mass Casualty Incident (MCI) as it presented five patients plus the deceased. Mutual aid was provided by Kent City FD and Rockford Ambulance requested mutual aid from Montcalm County Ambulance, Montcalm County Rescue, and Aeromed. After all patients were transported, SFD remained on scene to assist the medical examiner with victim removal and MSP with road closure and lighting for the investigation. Total time for alarm was 5.5 hours.
- On 8-20-20 a Critical Incident Stress Management meeting was provided at SFD Fire Station for all responders from all agencies involved in the aforementioned fatal MVA. 12 members from three agencies participated in this opportunity.
- On 8-27-20, the vendor performed SFD hose testing at the Cedar Springs Fire Station. SFD personnel transported trucks to the site for this testing. Failure rates were significant this year including five pieces of 2.5" hose and eight pieces of 1.75" hose. Also failing testing and condemned was a three section 35' foot ground ladder equipped on Engine 2 and a repair on the 10' folding ladder. Unfortunately all spare hose has been used after previous testing dates. Hose substitutions were made between the trucks leaving only critical deficiencies on Engine 2. Purchase requests for hose will need to be discussed. A ladder donation by other agency is being investigated by the Chief to replace the condemned ladder.
- On 8-31-20, the vendor performed SFD Pump Testing successfully for all apparatus. Some minor repairs were made to E 2 and other repair for E 1 will be scheduled. Pump and motor PM Service was performed the week before.
