Significant Events and/or Alarms

- Easter Sunday morning found many members responding to a structure fire at the LeMunyon Farm property instead of church. The first unit on scene reported smoke showing and started an offensive attack with hose lines. A quick knock down of a room and contents fire was the result. The structure burning was an old residential trailer home and was slated for removal/demolition. The building was uninsured and has since been removed from the property. The building was uninsured and current dollar loss value is zero. Cause and origin of the fire is undetermined. SFD was assisted by Kent City, Algoma, and Cedar Springs FD.
- On April 12, SFD responded to a reported mattress fire at 14897 Tree Valley with automatic aid from Cedar Springs, Sand Lake, and Algoma FD. First due crews rapidly removed the burning furniture from the structure and quickly mitigated any extension of the fire. This fire loss was estimated at \$ 12,000.00 and the origin of the fire was in an electrical outlet box.
- On April 28, FF Rob Schmidt and FF John Elliott successfully completed both the written and
 practical exams for the MFFTC FF 1 & 2 exam. A big thank you to John & Rob for all your hard
 work and sacrifice. After completing some follow up SFD orientation training requirements,

these two personnel will greatly support the backbone of our team. Following is a note from the academy sponsor, PFD Chief McKellar: "The students from PFD Firefighter Academy took their practical skills exam. I am pleased to say that all 24 students passed. On Thursday, the State of Michigan Bureau of Fire Services notified the course manager that the written exams have been finalized and informed him that all 24 students passed their written exam with a class average score of 84.4%. A student must score 70% or greater to pass the written exam. These 24 students represent most of the fire departments north of Four Mile Rd. in Kent County and are the face of the future fire service. I would like to commend the students and instructors for their hard work over the last 9 months to make this firefighter academy very successful."



- The grant awarded Breathing Air Compressor (BAC) has been serviced by the technician and has successfully compressed air into the storage cylinders. A sample of air was collected and will be tested for quality and purity requirements. Test results should be returned within 30 days.
- On 4-30-18, SFD received 26 new pager/radios from the KCDA. This equipment was obtained through the voter approved \$23.6 million dollar surcharge in November 2016. This surcharge will provide a new 12 site, 20 channel 700/800 MHz radio system and allow Kent County to join the statewide Michigan Public Safety Communication System (MPSCS). Current estimated completion of the new radio system is 4th quarter 2019. The value of this equipment obtained by SFD is \$ 16,000. This equipment will be stored in stock until the new radio system is operational or depletion of the current pager/radio stock outpaces demand.
