Significant Events and/or Alarms

- On 2-4-19, three members performed a pre-delivery final inspection of the new T-1 at B & B Fire Division. A short list of minor deficiencies was produced. Delivery occurred on 2-20-19. New deficiencies developed and the truck returned to vendor for additional repairs for a few days. The truck returned, members began to get some driving experience with the truck. The truck went in to service on 2-28-19 after a work detail to load equipment.
- Three members provided station coverage for approved leave on 2-4-19, 2-8-19, & 2-22-19.
- On February 18, 2019 SFD responded to an alarm that resulted in the death of three innocent children. Thankfully, SFD only responded to a staging area and was not summoned to the scene due to the establishment of a crime scene and obvious death. SFD received a tremendous amount of well wishes and general need inquiries from our partners in the fire service, business, community and personal friends. Thank you for your concerns and checking on our condition. Please forward those prayers and concerns to the law enforcement members who certainly must be struggling with this incident.
- On 2-8-19, E1, E2, & T1 were moved to G2 Crane on White Creek due to the loss of heat in building # 2. Of course, 1 hour after moving the trucks the power returned. Nonetheless, a big thank you to G2 Crane for being a great community partner.
- Diesel fuel was purchased from Hometown Express during a power outage at Meijer on February 8.
