**Outside of station functions/ Significant Events, Alarms:**

- SFD Tender 1 responded to its maiden alarm for a water shuttle operation in Algoma Township at a residential barn fire. Two personnel at the station completing their Fire Officer exam responded to the scene. Due to the exhaustion of the fuel supply, the fire was extinguished before the Tender was able or needed to offload the water.
- SFD responded to a structure fire at 545 Solon Road on May 21, 2019. The residential structure sustained moderate smoke and fire damage to the front room of the house and substantial water damage to the remaining structure in an effort to mitigate fire travel. The structure is uninhabitable and dollar loss was placed at \$90,000. The cause and origin is undetermined after extensive investigation from the fire investigator. There were no injuries reported.
- On May 21, 2019 the Kent County Fire Academy combined both the north (Plainfield FD) and west (Walker FD) academies to host a formal graduation ceremony. The event was held in the west wing of the Delta Plex entertainment center and was attended by over 300 guests. Dignitaries included MI State Fire Marshall Kevin Sehlmeier who gave the keynote address. Other dignitaries included 13 fire chiefs from various agencies that had students participating in the academy. Solon FD Chief Drake and Deputy Chief Paige were both in attendance to congratulate SFD FF's Bobo, Cebrero, Elias, and Kolenda.
- Solon FD hosted a water nursing operation regional training event on May 18, 2019. Guest instructor was Cannon Township Fire Chief Jim Morris. Chief Morris is recognized as the regional guru on water nursing operations and with more than 41 years of service, he certainly has the experience. The event was attended by our regional partners including Sand Lake, Sparta, Courtland, and Cannon Township fire departments.

- Received four new sets of turn-out gear (Pants and Coats) provided under the 50/50 matching grant awarded from the DNR.
- Flag pole repair at cemetery
- Tree removal from drain field at fire station
- Vacation leave coverage by FF Schievink on 5-3-19 for 10 hours
- Three SFD personnel attended the Velzy Park Pancake Breakfast to provide some PR for the FD.
