## Outside of Station Functions, Significant Events, Alarms:

- On December 7, 2020 SFD responded to two significant structure fire alarms, within a few hours of each other. The first event occurred at 1359 hours at 15797 Algoma Road. This fire started in a chicken coop that was attached to the residential structure. A lengthy delay in reporting the fire resulted in heavy fire growth prior to the arrival of the FD. This fire was fought in a defensive posture and resulted in the total loss of contents and structure estimated at \$200,000.00. SFD was assisted by Algoma, Cedar Springs, Kent City, Plainfield, Sand Lake, and Sparta fire departments. No civilian or FD injuries occurred at this event.

- While the crews were still at the station re-stocking the trucks from the previous structure fire, a new alarm was received for a structure fire at 43 Clear Lake. Arrival found mild smoke conditions in the basement of the structure. The initial investigation found that the fire was extinguished and SFD evacuated the smoke from the building. The fire was determined to be incendiary due to the deliberate act of a juvenile family member. The family was provided counseling resources. This fire was investigated by the Plainfield FD and Kent County Sheriff Department cooperatively. Mutual aid was provided by Algoma, Cedar Springs, Kent City, and Plainfield fire departments. Damage is estimated at \$ 500.00. No civilian or FD injuries occurred at this event.
- On December 15, 2020 SFD was summoned again for another structure fire. This fire was reported in an attached garage of a residence located at 16685 Antler Drive. SFD arrived on scene with the occupants outside, and fire through the roof of the garage and rapidly spreading to the interior of the house. An aggressive offensive attack was made by the FD. The bulk of the fire was quickly knocked down resulting in little loss of personal items. The owners of the home were extremely happy with our ability to save the residential side of the structure. Mutual aid was provided by Algoma, Cedar Springs, Plainfield, and Sand Lake fire departments. The cause and origin investigation was conducted by Plainfield FD and was determined to be the result of the careless discharge of smoking material. This finding was supported the next day by the private investigator for the insurance company, and an admission by the owner/occupant. Damage is estimated at \$ 275,000.00. No civilian or FD injuries occurred at this event.
- SFD also responded as an automatic aid partner to Kent City FD for two structure fire alarms on December 1, 2019 on 20 Mile Road NW. This fire was quickly knocked down by arriving Kent City and Solon members. SFD responded with two apparatus and five personnel. A few hours later, SFD was summoned again to the same address but was disregarded prior to arrival.
- SFD failed to respond to three alarms in the month of December. Two of the alarms ended up getting transferred to the Kent City FD, both were Priority 1 medical alarms. Kent City was cancelled by the ALS agency prior to their arrival at both alarms. The third alarm that SFD failed to respond to was a mutual aid request for the Tender to a structure fire in Kent City.
