

Minutes – Planning Commission

September 27, 2017 7:30 PM Solon Township Hall

Meeting called by: Chairperson, Ellen Moore @ 7:32 PM Members present: Babcock, Gunnell, Moore, Myers, Sevey, Sawade, Tilburt

Approval of Minutes: Motion to accept August Minutes as written by Gunnell, second by Sawade, All Ayes, Carried.

Approval of Agenda: All agreed

Agenda Item: Public Hearing

Proposal: Zoning Ordinance Amendment – Driveway Access to Back Lots

Moore: Called public hearing open for comment:

- *Comment*: Jackie Sopczynski is for what's currently being proposed concerns about having to do a site condo.
 - Terri Waite family wishes to build a condo site @ 13610 Kroskroft

Moore: Closed public hearing after no additional comment

- *Consideration*: Mark suggested a possible solution recently raised was to do a site condominium for these situations. Condo for 2 lots, Unit 1 & Unit 2 that wouldn't need frontage regulations. This could be an alternative now and protect other amenities of the ordinance in question.
- *Discussion*: Access would be a driveway that would be required to meet standards; There would a necessary common area; there would be legal hurdles for the applicant i.e. master deed would be necessary; a deed for each unit would be necessary; PC doesn't have to do anything if this route is taken; private drive can only serve 2 dwellings. The current ordinance would allow a front split only if required frontage is maintained.
- *PC Concerns*: Driveway access and township's responsibility to maintain; and existing procedures (Ch13b) adherence.
- Conclusion: PC agreed to move to next agenda item

Agenda Item: Medical Marijuana Facilities

Proposal: Ordinance to Allow Medical Marijuana Facility Operation in Solon Township *Moore*: Not a public hearing but opened for public comment

- **Comment: Dr. Michael Carlton: Could be possible opposition due to constituents not having a choice to operate a legal business; benefit to township regarding license fee revenue.
 - Derrin Leigh: Continues to meet/educate township officials on this issue; believes township parks/roads would benefit from revenue; vote in 2008 passed in Solon Township so constituents have already spoken in favor.
 - Helen Potter: against facilities
 - Eileen Driesenga: against facilities
 - General concerns: promotion driven by revenue vs. caring for our residents; if constituents want/need this, can get it elsewhere; really a demand?

Discussion: Solon considering facilities information is spreading, interest is growing; experiencing

positive results from oils, tinctures; enforcement control with limited resources since violators are reported to the state and township is limited; Amount of licensing and flexibility to change in future; future legislative decisions are unpredictable; Unclear zoning (currently AG or Ind.) for dispensaries; demand won't be determined until it exists.

- *Concerns*: Rise in opiate use; Marijuana is illegal at federal level; debate isn't about medical marijuana, just whether facilities are here; regulating production; licensing stipulations and limitations; location of facility re: near churches, schools, etc.,
- *Conclusion*: Mark will draft a preliminary resolution for 2 farms and 2 dispensaries for the PC to review perhaps October or November. May consider another public hearing in the future. Township Board will have final approval.
- *Moore*: Public consideration closed for now insured public that PC's decision isn't determined by dollars. Moved to next item.

Agenda Item: Neighborhood Vehicle Sales – Sam Adams Motors – Hussam Dabaja Proposal-A: Revised Zoning Ordinance Amendment for Neighborhood Vehicle Sales

Discussion: Review of draft changes. Setback requirements for the township and the state; building/office wouldn't be in setback, but vehicles in that area are a problem; would front yard be for parking or vehicle display with vision conflict; once approved a state assessor needs to sign off before license; Signage clause F removal/revision; Huck's Corner's lot isn't relevant – grandfathered in.

Conclusion: Mark will revise make provision to 75' right-of-way; Dabaja's architect can work with MDOT. *Moore*: Motion to accept ordinance w/sentence (F) removal and subject to engineer's report. So moved by Gunnell, Second by Sevey. All ayes – Motion carried.

Proposal-B: Resolution Approving Preliminary Site Plan Review for Neighborhood Vehicle Sales *Discussion*: Review of draft. Subject to MDOT approval and site plan. Item H – parking spaces for public (28); Dabaja – "never more than 3 or 4 customers at one time."

Moore: Motion to accept resolution. So moved by Sevey, Second by Gunnell. All ayes – Motion carried.

Agenda Item: No Wake ordinance for Middle Lake

Conclusion: Mark – no need to consider – will be addressed by the Township Board.

Agenda Item: Master Plan – Bob Toland

Proposal: Review of final draft

Discussion: Insert information on Velzy Park Project; grammar and verbiage changes/editions throughout document; current maps can't be read now but will be 11" X 17" fold-outs.

- *Conclusion*: Mark no public hearing yet, will go to Board. Bob will distribute new copy with changes for the PC to see again for public hearing.
- *Moore*: Motion to approve Master Plan with changes. So moved by Gunnell, Second by Sevey. All Ayes motion carried.
- *Open Discussion for Audience*: Jeff Twyman, Cannon Township Planning Commission. RE: Medical Marijuana had handouts from State; approval of caregiving growers in Cannon Township; not approving commercial licenses.
